*Re: Purchase of Liquor by Port Madison Enterprises and its Tribal Enterprises is Authorized*

To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised that Port Madison Enterprises (“PME”), a governmental agency of the Suquamish Tribe, is party to a Memorandum of Agreement with the Liquor and Cannabis Board effective January 7, 2015 (“MOA”). Under the MOA, PME and its Tribal Enterprises (which include, without limitation, Suquamish Clearwater Casino Resort, Kiana Lodge, Masi Shop, Suquamish Village Chevron, Longhouse Texaco, and White Horse Golf) are eligible to order, purchase, and take delivery of beer, wine, and spirits. A traditional liquor license is not issued to the Tribe in the presence of an MOA.

**The annual fees under the MOA are paid through May 31, 2018.**
